

Lesson Plans – Week of January 7, 2019

Monday, January 7 – Work on Public Service Announcement (Due 20 minutes into class on Tuesday). If you're working with a partner, your commercial needs to be around 90 seconds. If you are working alone, your PSA should be around 45 seconds. Remember, regardless of the program you are using (powerpoint, Google slides, Prezi, a produced video) your PSA should play on its own (without having to advance slides). I have not been able to figure out a way to do this on Office Powerpoint Online, so once you have finished your slides in Powerpoint Online, click on the "Open in Powerpoint" feature. Once there, go to the "Transitions" tab and all the way to the left you will see the options to manually change slides or to automatically change slides. Remember, you have to change this setting on ALL of the slides. You can change the amount of time a slide appears before transitioning to the next slide. Also, consider embedding sounds, music, and a short video for additional impact.

Tuesday, January 8 – 20 minutes to finalize PSA and upload to Schoology. After, we will begin watching The Glass Castle movie.

Wednesday, January 9 – First, a discussion regarding the card marking extra credit. As discussed several times previously, the extra credit is not an assignment on Khan Academy as the website does not allow me to assign SAT prep. The extra credit is to achieve skill level 4 on ALL 21 Grammar and Effective Language Use tutorials.

After the extra credit discussion and demonstration, we will continue watching The Glass Castle movie. We will stop the movie during the last 10 minutes of class to discuss the director's choices as many scenes from the book are not depicted in the movie. Do the deletions and additions change the tone and overall message of the book?

Thursday, January 10 – We will finish the movie and once again discuss the differences between the book and the movie. The contents of these discussions are fair game for midterm exam questions.

Friday, January 11 – Review midterm exam vocabulary. After, discuss the remaining elements of the midterm.
