College Specific Scholarships

- **University of Michigan-Sigma Phi Epsilon**-The University of Michigan chapter of Sigma Phi Epsilon is sponsoring the Balanced Man Scholarship. The \$1,000, \$500, and \$250 scholarship is available to any male attending the University of Michigan in the Fall of 2012. The applicant is under no obligation to join any organization to be eligible for consideration. General Scholarships

- **Student Insights**-The 2010 Student-View Scholarship Program is offering \$10,000 worth of scholarships to high school seniors who plan to attend a four-year college, community college/junior college, or career school. Simply log onto www.studenview.com and complete a 15-20 minute survey about colleges in your area. The scholarship will be awarded via random drawing of all completed applications. The scholarship deadline is **April 22, 2010**.

- **Arab American and Chaldean Council (ACC)**- The ACC Scholarship Awards Program is available once a year to graduating high school seniors. Scholarships are based on academic excellence and financial need. Applicants must be a high school senior, who has been accepted to college, with a GPA of 3.0 or higher, and has demonstrated leadership skill, extracurricular/ volunteer activities. - **Realtors Association**-The Realtors Association Scholarship Fund provides financial assistance for high school seniors attending a Michigan college or university. - **Extra Credit Union**-Extra Credit Union offers \$2,000 scholarships to help defray the cost of college expenses. Applications are available at www.extracreditunion.org/scholarships or at any in-school branch. The application deadline is **April 20, 2012**.
- **Community Foundation**-Two tri-county students graduating in June 2012, and enrolling, in college in the fall of 2012, will be selected to receive a \$2,000 scholarship. These scholarships are renewable for three additional years that the recipients are in college. Students must have at least 3.2 GPA and strong standardized test scores. - **Michigan Association of School Personnel**-High School seniors who are members of a minority ethnic group and who plan to pursue an education degree may apply for consideration of this \$1,000 scholarship award. The \$1,000 scholarship covers the first two years and can be renewed when the student is accepted into the College of Education in year three, for a total of \$2000. Apply by **May 1, 2012**. - **Chaldean Federation of America Scholarship Program**-The Annual Chaldean Federation of America Scholarship Program is approaching very quickly!
