### **College Specific Scholarships**

- **Kenyon College**-Kenyon College's trustees are pleased to announce new extraordinary renewable scholarships based solely on academic talent. The college will award five full-tuition and five half-tuition scholarships, renewable with satisfactory academic progress. - **Thiel College**-Thiel College in Greenville, PA will hold its annual Academic Scholarship competition events for high school seniors in January. Award ranges vary from \$500 up to 5 full tuition scholarships. Students that meet the minimum requirements of an ACT composite score of 19 and a 3.0 cumulative GPA are eligible to compete. - **College for Creative Studies**-Students who demonstrate exceptional artistic ability, as evidenced by a portfolio with very strong technical and conceptual skills, are eligible for the Walter B. Ford II Award of Academic Excellence, a full-tuition scholarship to CCS. To be considered for nomination, visit the counseling center by **December 17, 2012**.
- **Washington and Lee University (W&L)**-Annually, W&L admissions department selects about 200 students as finalists for the Johnson Scholarship and

host their visits to the campus at the University's expense. Winners are chosen from this group, and the Johnson Program funds their W&L education fully, amounting to about 10 percent of each enrolling class (40-50 students each year).
